Emotions Run High as City Reveals Proposals to Change Zoning Rules

Voices in English, Cantonese and Mandarin overlapped and echoed throughout a theater room at the Josiah Quincy Upper School on Jan. 18 at a city-sponsored meeting on rezoning plans for Chinatown. Property owners, business owners, and community leaders had various - and often conflicting opinions about the rezoning proposal. One of the most contentious issues was a set of plans to dramatically change zoning heights for some types of buildings in Chinatown, which has seen several high-rise luxury housing towers proposed and built over the past couple decades. The neighborhood is currently reviewing a 25-story hotel proposal at the site of the old See Sun grocery store. Proposed zoning changes would allow 350-foot heights

for some types of "affordable" housing projects and 150-foot limits for some other types of projects.

This rezoning effort is part of the implementation of "PLAN: Downtown (2018-2023)" and a citywide effort to rezone many areas, according to City of Boston planner Jack Halverson.

The proposal separates Chinatown into several categories based on use and focuses on changes in four zoning districts, residential-1 (R-1), community commercial (CC), residential-10 (R-10), and mixed-use 10 (MU-10).

In R-1, residential buildings under 15 units and ground floor small grocery stores would be allowed. The maximum building height would be lowered from 80 feet to 45 feet, the maximum square footage would be

1,500, and some small "backyard" additions could be possible. According to the proposal, this is all an effort to "downzone" and put dimensional regulations in place to maintain row houses and small businesses.

The community commercial regulations include a maximum building height of 80 feet, as it is now, and a 2,000 square foot maximum, and high building lot coverage. City officials say this is to "focus on maintaining what's there today and encouraging commercial activity with zoning rules that allow it."

In R-10, or residential-10, the proposal aims to increase affordable housing by increasing building height, with 350 feet allowed for housing and 150 feet for other uses. It also says, "Buildings must reduce size above 70 feet, or to the height of an abutting historic building."

For mixed use buildings – or MU-10 – the building heights would also be allowed to rise to 350 feet for affordable housing sites and 150 feet for other uses.

"Buildings must reduce size above 155 feet, or to the height of an abutting historic building," the proposal says.

During the comment period, Roman Chan, president of the Chinatown Business Association, said rebuilding would be expensive and would not help convince people that left Chinatown due to high rent to move back.

"A lot of our members have their opinions regarding the restrictions," Chan said to a Sampan reporter. "Especially the height and the way they split this small so-called business district into two sub-districts."

One Chinatown resident and real estate broker said that reducing the building height meant limiting the growth opportunities for property owners. He compared it to telling high school students they were going to college and then later taking that opportunity away from them.

Another concern that several people brought up was the low-quality, unsafe, and expensive state of many of the residential buildings now.

One speaker brought with him newspaper clips displayed on a board and annotated copies of the Chinatown rezoning. He called attention to existing building conditions. He said the only way to improve housing is to increase affordable housing.

"In Chinatown, many of the houses are dilapidated. We need to rejuvenate," he said, to which he was met with applause. He spoke directly to City Councilor Ed Flynn,

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who was present, telling him to walk into any basement on Hudson or Tyler Street to see the poor state of the buildings; he also expressed concern about increased crime in Chinatown.

His speech stirred up many people at the meeting, and voices began to swirl around the room.

"I'm not going to allow division and personal attacks on anyone," Flynn interrupted during the meeting. "Because whether you agree with them or disagree with them, I expect a respectful meeting."

City officials said meetings on the rezoning effort, which would also remove the "adult entertainment" district from the neighborhood and call for other changes, will be ongoing. More information can be found at https://www.bostonplans.org/getattachment/e6052842-d5b3-4ac6-9072-bdc3b857b851.





How I Led Natick's 1st Lunar New Year Festival

During my Sophomore year in high school, I sat down with my beloved Chinese Culture Club adviser to begin planning one of the most significant events our school club has ever held: a townwide Lunar New Year celebration.

I am now a junior at Natick High School, and have been president of the Chinese Culture Club since my sophomore year. In the town of Natick, an unremarkable little suburb a fifth the size of Boston, townwide holiday recognition only really extends to the big five: Valentine's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving, Hanukkah and Christmas. Growing up, I was the only Chinese student at my elementary school of 200 students, and even now remain one of the few at my high school. Indeed, with only 7% of the population Asian, cultural representation was, and can still be, hard to come by.

Ironically, the spark that started our festival effort began with a petition for the school board to make the Lunar New Year a school holiday. It failed. Disappointed but undeterred, my adviser and I began thinking of other ways we could teach our community more about the Chinese culture that meant so much to us. Many other towns have had Lunar New Year festivals, we thought, and so came the courage to decide it was time for a proper celebration. Of course, the anticipation and excitement we had didn't make it any less work, and my adviser and I had pretty big dreams.

Anyone familiar with the televised national New Year's Gala Program on CCTV, or "Chun Wan," as it is referred to in China, knows that it is the biggest event of the year. Hundreds of millions of people tune in to watch each year, and enjoy cultural performances, song, dance, opera, poetry, cross-talk, and short dramas. And we were not about to do it any disrespect if we could help it.

The next couple of months, we focused on getting in touch with different groups in the area. We were originally unsure whether we would be able to get the exposure and support needed to pull off the festival. Yet, as we pitched the idea to our community and communities beyond, more and more people became inspired by the idea of a Lunar New Years Gala that was long overdue. First, we contacted, and were contacted by, many Chinese-American households, some

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Doctor's Prescription for Injustice: Speak Up

Dr. Yipeng Ge, already outspoken on genocide of indigenous peoples, took deep a dive into Palestine studies at Harvard

While at Harvard University's T.H. Chan School of Public Health a couple years ago, Dr. Yipeng Ge faced a dilemma – and the decision he would make would profoundly influence the following years of his life.

Already outspoken on the genocide of indigenous people and racism in North America, Dr. Ge discovered the Palestine Program during graduate studies at Harvard. Also taking courses in the Kennedy School and Harvard Law, he then soon found out about Palestine Trek, or PalTrek. In that private program, he could travel to the West Bank and occupied Jerusalem. He wanted to go to supplement his studies, but had a moral problem: Was it ethical for him to go?

"I considered going, but wasn't sure if it was right for me to go, knowing my Palestinian friends and colleagues do not have their right of return," Dr. Ge told the Sampan during a recent phone interview.

Dr. Ge, 30, who is now practicing family medicine in Canada, wanted to learn more about Palestine first-hand, but he also knew of Palestinian friends and colleagues who had not even gone back themselves — "and some of them

never had been there because their parents or grandparents were exiled from historic Palestine." During the Nakba – or "Catastrophe" – of 1948, for example, hundreds of thousands of Palestinians were pushed from their homes and many were forced to become refugees, often within their own state. Israeli forces have continued to push out many more Palestinians in the decades since.

After getting the blessing of his Palestinian friends, he went on the trip in March of 2023, where, he said, he "bore witness to overt occupation and apartheid." Since then, he's been a vocal advocate of Palestinian human rights, and went on to write a graduate paper called, "Settler Colonialism, Health, and Palestine."

But knowing and seeing the human rights violations faced by so many Palestinians came with another dilemma: How much should he speak out?

Dr. Ge knew the consequences.

"I was very aware of this chilling effect of anti-Palestinian – 'progressive except for Palestine' – racism," he said, referring to people who act liberal on many issues, but stay mum on abuses carried out by the government of Israel, often with support of the U.S.

So when he did show solidarity with

Palestinians, he, like so many others in academia, faced swift backlash. Another, higher-ranking medical colleague, Dr. Ge said, targeted him for his social media "likes" and reposts following Israel's barrage on Gaza in response to the Oct. 7 Hamas attack. The senior doctor claimed that Dr. Ge was spreading anti-Semitic and inflammatory posts.

Soon after, said Dr. Ge, the Canadian Medical Association reprimanded him and the University of Ottawa, where he was on faculty in the residency training program, suspended him. Dr. Ge said the association told him to apologize to people he was accused of offending for liking posts, including one with images of a person holding a "From the river to the sea, Palestine will be free" sign.

An outcry of support for Dr. Ge followed. A petition to reinstate the doctor and seek an inquiry into the university's handling of the matter quickly got tens of thousands of signatures and is now at over 100,000. The University of Ottawa eventually offered to reinstate him, but he ultimately resigned, as he did from his position in the medical association. In his lengthy letter of resignation to the Canadian Medial As-

Activism Through Art: Interview With Carlos Hernandez, Chavez,

You could say that artist Carlos Hernandez Chavez has taken a bit of the Mexican Muralist Movement of the 1900s to modern-day New England.

But his path to painting on walls and buildings here after growing up in Mexico was a winding one.

In the mid-1960s, Chavez devoted his education to the arts while still in Mexico. He studied at the Escuela Nacional de Artes Plásticas-UNAM at the Academia de San Carlos in Mexico and INBA's Escuela de Pintura y Escultura at La Esmeralda. He also pursued a life in rock 'n' roll. It was the latter that took him to the Northeast U.S. decades ago, in hopes of joining a rock band that was auditioning on the West Coast. Instead, Chavez ended up staying in Connecticut, where he would marry his then girlfriend, Georgianne "Georgie" Nelson.

To pay the bills, he put down his bass guitar and paint brush, and settled into a career in social work and for the city of Hartford. He started out at a psychiatric hospital and moved on from there.

But he didn't give up his passion for painting – or activism – and began creating murals around town. His first in the U.S. was a work he completed in the early 1970s, called the "Human Condition," which is now at the San Juan Center social agency in Hartford. He would go on to create many more public works through the decades and, through a grant from the then Connecticut Commission on the Arts, become involved in artists' rights and other social issues across the state.

Now, in his early 80s, Chavez has won recognition from his home country, when he received the 2024 Distinguished Mexicans Recognition award last month from the Consulate General of Mexico in Boston.

Sampan recently interviewed Chavez by email to find out more about him and his work. Following is an edited version of that exchange:

Sampan: Mexico, I think, has a long history of mural art as activism. First and most obviously what comes to mind is the great works of Diego Rivera. Was Mexico's muralist movement an influence on your work?

Chavez: My artistic training in the academic tradition was intensive, receiving instruction from masters whose works are now found in many prestigious institutions in Mexico and abroad, among them Ignacio Asúnsolo, Luis Nishizawa, Manuel Herrera Cartalla, Fernando Castro Pacheco, Héctor Cruz, and others. Many of these artists were contemporaries of Los Tres Grandes, Diego Rivera, David Alfaro Siqueiros and José Clemente Orozco — the most influential muralists of the 20th

century. During the construction of the new Museo Nacional de Antropología e Historia in 1964, I was recruited by Maestro Raúl Anguiano as an assistant muralist to Spanish artist Regina Raúll whose mural was installed and remains at the museum. There is no doubt that during my training, mural works in the Mexican tradition were a significant influence later on in my mural work.

Sampan: Could you describe a couple of your works that you're most proud of and what they mean to you?

Chavez: My 1974 "The Human Condition Mural" was the defining work that would help establish my direction as an activist painter in the state. It addressed issues affecting the lives of the people I served as a social worker that remain very relevant to this day: poverty, racism, child and elderly neglect, alcohol and drug addiction, and the inherent power in people to overcome them. This mural underwent several relocations (in part because of) opposition from public agencies' executives....(At which point the) mural was put in the trash, and later rescued by Doris Rojas, a good friend.


Another is "The Wall of Forgiveness." The 1995 work was an ephemeral mural painted at Hartford's Charter Oak Cultural Center with gang violence as its central theme. In the previous five years, Hartford had experienced a high number of homicides - nearly 200. My intention was to bring public awareness by offering alternative ways to reduce violence in bold, graphic terms. The mural displayed all the names of those killed, painted above the figure of a young man prostrated over the word 'FORGIVENESS'. My belief is that if forgiveness is not given or accepted, the healing process can't begin.

(I created) "River of Memories, River of Hope" in 2001 at the Catholic Charities, Refugee Resettlement Office, with the intention of bringing awareness and resources to world refugees being resettled in the Hartford Area on the scourge of HIV/AIDS. This mural had an unfortunate end, being painted over in 2008 by order of the agency's then executive director under the pretense that "the images were not appropriate for the clients' viewing." A justification beyond ironic.

"Sugar Beet Workers" ... painted in 2009 under a grant from the Roberts Foundation for the Arts ... is my way of telling my personal immigrant story....

Sampan: It sometimes seems that art and architecture are less and less an imperative for many towns and cities in the U.S. How important do you feel public art's role is in people's well being?

Chavez: In my nearly 60 years here, my impression regarding public art

in Connecticut, particularly socially conscious or controversial murals, is not as well received or understood here as in other parts of the country. One will hardly find those kinds of works, much less those that contain nudity in public places in the state. I think this is a direct result of the conservative, puritanical attitudes and narrow knowledge about mural art of those who control what the public can see or read.

Sampan: You've now lived a good part of your life in Connecticut. Looking back, how welcoming has it been as an immigrant from Mexico?

Chavez: I found that in general, the people around the places I've lived are good, generous and kind. Unfortunately, there will always be some who aren't. In my earlier years here I had my share of unpleasant situations regarding my looks and native origin both from people and the authorities. I was often seen more with curiosity, given that I am, according to the media, the first Mexican to settle in Hartford. For the first 15 years or so I did not encounter any Mexicans here. People that I've known over the years have learned much about Mexican culture through me; conversely, I've learned so much not only about American life, but about

many cultures from abroad, especially the Puerto Ricans, who I consider my second family.

Sampan: Finally, you've said that you come from a family of migrant farm workers and that "a lot of people have a stigma attached to that. I don't. I pride myself in that heritage." I think that's interesting because farming and the farming industry is so dependent on these workers. Now, it seems, migrant workers in general have become a political target. How do you react to some of the political rhetoric we've heard of late about immigrants and immigrant workers?

Chavez: Having been the recipient of repeated verbal attacks, aggression and mocking during my early years here because of my national origin and language, I've long learned to deflect and educate, rather than to respond in kind. Not too many are aware that society would suffer immeasurably were it not for farming, and the threats of deportation of undocumented farm workers in this country are sure to create unnecessary anxiety and fear, and are cruel and inhumane. I think the logistics of mass deportations are unrealistic, undoable and unenforceable.

Muslim Lawyer Event to Tackle Big Issues of Faith, Bias and Law

Civil rights attorney Mariam Aydah knows what it's like to be singled out for being a Muslim while practicing — and studying — law.

A few incidents stand out in particular. Once, while handling a case, she was mistaken for a client, even after co-counsel introduced her as one of the client's lawyers. Another time, while in college, a professor who often associated Muslims with terrorists offhandedly rejected a paper she wrote that presented Islam in a positive light.

And then there was the time she was working at a courthouse where everyone was familiar with her, but that didn't stop security officials from holding her up in line to scan her bag – over and over again – in the metal detector, as people behind her began peering over to see what was going on.

"I was asked to repeatedly put my bag through the scanner," said Aydah, a lawyer with the Massachusetts chapter of the Council on American-Islamic Relations. She offered to let the court officers open her bag to inspect it.

But, "the officers refused to open it and kept running it through the scanner, making a spectacle in front of a growing line of onlookers."

The court officers finally opened the bag and discovered their "security concern" was merely ... lip gloss.

"I felt singled out, embarrassed, and deeply offended. It was a stark reminder of how being visibly Muslim can subject you to unwarranted scrutiny, even in professional settings where you're supposed to belong," she said.

Aydah is not alone. A high-profile case of anti-Muslim bias was arguably on full display recently during the failed appointment of Adeel Mangi for the U.S. Court of Appeals. Lawmakers grilled Mangi, a prominent Pakistani-American attorney, with loaded questions about his views on 9/11 and the Hamas attack on Israel.

"Does Israel have a right to exist?" asked one U.S. Senator at the confirmation hearings.

It is against this backdrop that Aydah is organizing the "Future Muslim Lawyers" panel discussion in Roxbury on Feb. 1 at the Islamic Society of Boston Cultural Center. At the event, over a dozen Muslim

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Mitsuye Endo Tsutsumi Persisted – And Helped End Mass Incarceration of Japanese Americans

Mitsuye Endo Tsutsumi didn't set out to be a civil rights hero. And she didn't promote herself as one. But she played a key role in ending the mass incarceration of Japanese Americans – many of them U.S. citizens – during World War II.

"Mitsuye was an ordinary person who was caught up in an extraordinary circumstance," explains writer Frank Abe, who was part of a team who first told the personal story of Endo Tsutsumi in print, in the graphic novel, We Hereby Refuse: Japanese American Resistance to Wartime Incarceration, published in 2021.

Endo Tsutsumi was recently honored, nearly two decades after her death, for her role in ending the Japanese incarceration camps. She was awarded a Presidential Citizens Medal earlier this month by former U.S. Pres. Joe Biden.

But Endo Tsutsumi's story is much less known than, say that of the late civil rights activist Fred Korematsu – another U.S. citizen ordered to the incarceration camps amid U.S. hysteria following the attacks on Pearl Harbor. Instead of defying orders, Endo Tsutsumi reported to her camp, but became part of lawsuit after she and her colleagues were illegally fired by the state of California. The lawyer who took on the case, James Purcell, ended up not only challenging the firings of the Japanese Americans, but also their entire incarceration – a story Abe and his team tell in engaging and compelling detail and imagery in We Hereby Refuse.

"What attorney James Purcell was

doing was what attorneys do today, which was cherry picking his clients. He cherry-picked Endo, because she was a 'perfect plaintiff,'" explained

She checked all the necessary boxes needed for a time of intense hatred of Japanese. She was Christian. She had a brother in the U.S. Army. She did not attend Japanese language schools.

But, in the end, perhaps just as important, she persisted for the greater good of the more than 120,000 other Japanese Americans also forced to the prison camps in the Western U.S. She refused an offer to leave that would have allowed her to go home months earlier but also prevent her from continuing her case.

"She was presented with the opportunity, by an attorney, who, with a conscience, wanted to bring a case against the government to contest this injustice," said Abe. "She was reluctant at first, but she eventually agreed, and that agreement is what makes her worthy of recognition today, of honor today."

Because of Endo Tsutsumi's battle, in December of 1944, the U.S. Supreme Court handed down an order that effectively ended the incarceration of the Japanese Americans because there was no proof they were disloyal to the U.S. (The decision came at the same time period as Korematsu's loss in the court.)

But despite her role in U.S. civil rights history, Endo Tsutsumi is – outside of the West Coast – a rather obscure figure. Her presidential recognition, in fact, came nearly 80 years after the fact.

"The history books had told the

outlines of her biography, but not her personal feelings, motivations, experiences and journey – her personal journey from working for the state of California, in Sacramento, to a series of incarceration camps and her eventual case in the Supreme Court," said Abe. "That story had not been fully explored, I think."

Abe explains that part of the reason why is her personality. "She was shy and self-effacing. She didn't feel she did anything special."

The other reason is her family didn't promote her legacy.

But after a campaign from the Japanese-American community last year to have Pres. Biden award her the Medal of Freedom, she ended up getting, posthumously, the Presidential Citizens Medal.

But even though her case had led to the eventual closing of the camps, Abe warns the story of Japanese incarceration is "not some isolated historical incident."

He draws parallels to the 1940s and the family separations of undocumented immigrants at the southern border with "kids in cages and persecution of immigrants" during the first Trump Administration. And he fears it could happen again after threats of mass deportations and with increasing rhetoric demonizing China.

"I would encourage people to look at this history of Japanese Americans for a precedent of what can happen when these things get out of control."

Abe will discuss "We Hereby Refuse" at Wellesley College on April 22 from 4:30-6 p.m. ET. Abe was contacted for this interview through the help of the nonprofit group Densho.

sociation, he wrote, in part: "Criticism of the actions of Israeli governments is not antisemitic. Criticizing Zionism as a nationalist ideology is not antisemitic. Nor is expressing support for a future in which Palestinians and Israelis can live in equality. We all benefit when we are all freer." (The Canadian Medical Association said in its response at the time that certain posts by Dr. Ge "were received as harmful by some members of the medical profession" and that the association and Dr. Ge "both agreed to participate in a restorative process to repair relationships." The University of Ottawa did not respond to a request for comment.)

Instead of backing away from the criticism, he pushed on with his activism. He continued to speak out against Israel's bombardment of Palestinians. He also went to Gaza in February of 2024, providing volunteer medical services in an old school building in Rafa, where he saw starving children, burn victims and a lack of medical supplies.

But all this came at a cost to his career and reputation.

"I appreciate Dr. Ge's resilience, and the example he sets of how to stand up to bullies and maintain moral integrity," said Joanna Berry, an immigration and refugee lawyer in Canada, who follows the doctor's activism. "As a University of Ottawa alum and former Ottawa resident, I have observed through news and networks that the crackdowns against pro-Palestinian activists and scholars are especially violent in Ottawa.... Bully tactics range from the overzealous, reckless deployment of the Ottawa Police Service ... to forms of institutional and lawfare violence, which Dr. Ge has certainly encountered through his work."

From Wuhan to Activism

The family doctor's activism, however, didn't start with Palestine. Dr. Ge was born in Wuhan, China, where his parents had attended university. As a small child, his family later lived in Japan for a few years and then when he was about four years old they relocated to Waterloo, Canada.

"My parents wanted a ... better life for me as a kid — to grow up in Canada," he said, of his childhood.

He said he's always felt like an outsider – both in Canada where he's a first-generation immigrant and in China, where he still has family but is seen as "Western."

"That family experience really made me think about what is my identity growing up in Canada," he said.

But then as he got older, he learned of Canada as a "settler-colonial state." He also learned of the crimes against the indigenous people of North America and how the native people's land was stolen, resulting in the current nation from which he reaps advantages, including the ability to pursue a

career in medicine.

"I worked in and entered medicine and public health, for that matter, in Canada – recognizing people's genocide here on Turtle Island," he said. "That was, for me, one of the biggest, shocking worldview shifts."

"I was like, How do I live in this world in a way that hopefully does less harm and hopefully helps dismantle some of these systems of oppression?"

He then focused on "settler colonialism" and how it affects public health, after he first learned in-depth about Canada's genocide of indigenous peoples – First Nations, Inuit, and Métis – during his undergraduate studies at McMaster University in Hamilton, Ontario.

"I learned from community members, activists, and clinicians who studied and worked in indigenous health, many of whom were from Six Nations of the Grand River, the largest First Nations reservation that exists in Canada to this day," he said.

"So, understanding what's happening in Palestine makes a lot of sense. I stumbled upon Palestine because of that."

On Speaking Up

"When we know right from wrong, we have to draw attention to those things," said Dr Ge, who appears to view human rights activism as inseparable from public health.

He also sees the crackdowns on free speech and protest at universities and other institutions recently as highly problematic.

And he learned about the latter the hard way over the past year, as have many who've come under scrutiny and received reprimands from universities and other institutions. Dr. Ge said because of his recent time at Harvard, including a 2024 course about social medicine in Palestine, he's followed some of what's happened in the Boston area that appears similar to what happened to him in Canada. And he said the censorship and silencing has caused his colleagues – even those who've witnessed firsthand the atrocities in Gaza – to avoid speaking out.

"Academic institutions say they are for one thing ... like academic advancement of speech, dialog and research papers and whatnot, but they are actually very much for something else," said Dr. Ge, who argues that the financial interests of many institutions often outweigh their value of free speech.

"Academic institutions," he said, "care more about their budgets and their donors than their students. ... They will always side with who has more power."

But, he added: "This chilling effect is really dangerous for free speech – for being able to talk about genocide, which is something that any doctor should be able to talk about, especially about its impacts on health and healthcare."

immigrants, others multi-generational diaspora. More and more families decided that this was an occasion worth their effort. Without the help of so many determined families, I can easily promise, the gala would not have been as successful as it was.

We wanted the entertainment to be unparalleled in quality: family friendly, engaging, and nostalgic. While kids delighted in the craft stations our hired artisans ran, adults enjoyed the familiarity of traditional Chinese performances. Families had children eager to present their own skills in the Chinese arts, including many that practiced those skills at a Chinese school a couple towns over. Students from our very own Chinese Culture Club also took pride in performing traditional music in groups of band and choir.

Initially reading down the program, I was delighted yet equally surprised at the many events that were scheduled. Opera singing, traditional dance, and poetry — all arts I rarely saw performed in the community and had rendered lost in translation. Finally, it seemed, our performers found an outlet and opportunity to present their skills to an audience that could truly appreciate the tradition and culture that fueled their passion. As professionals and children performed one after another, I felt a heartwarming sensation that, even in such a tiny suburb as Natick, Chinese culture had found a way to flourish and grow from generation to generation.

By far, the most stressful part of running the festival was food logistics, despite that a local Chinese restaurant provided delicious food. The biggest problem was we had no idea how many people to expect and when to expect them. By the time we were two weeks before launch day, we had sold approximately 200 tickets. Then, seemingly out of nowhere, 100 more orders piled in. The day of

the festival, we had hoards of people buying tickets at the door. All of this made it difficult to estimate the amount of food we needed, and we cut it so close so that there was only one extra serving of food left by the time everyone had gotten their plate. One!

Naturally, the festival had the extra flair such that a New Year's festival in suburban Massachusetts inevitably invites. We had stand up comedians, cracking jokes in Mandarin and English that had the crowd roaring with laughter. A street dance group from Boston University, volunteers who had asked to be included, jammed to Chinese songs that the high schoolers in attendance gladly sang along to.

It was a dream come true.

Filling each seat in the cafeteria, the fateful spot we were able to reserve from the school, were over 350 people, eating, laughing, and talking excitedly in many languages. Young children, dressed in all different shades of red, used clumsy fingers to shape clay figurines at the direction of talented artisans. Girls and boys in traditional clothing practiced the lines of the songs they were going to perform, while others adjusted their clothes for dance. Older performers chatted amongst themselves, exchanging anecdotes and experiences. Others conversed with younger performers of the same art, offering advice and encouragement.

The excitement in the room was palpable, and so was the pride. Surrounded by the unmistakable red of Lunar New Year decorations, the smell of good food, and a familiar language in our ears, hundreds of people had found a place to feel proud for being who we are.

Decidedly, it felt like home.

lawyers will discuss diverse opportunities within the legal field and "break down misconceptions about law."

Sampan interviewed Aydah about the event by email earlier this month. Following is an edited version of that exchange.

Sampan: What are a few unique considerations people of Muslim faith may consider, if any, when pursuing law?

Aydah: Muslims considering a career in law often grapple with the question of whether it is possible to uphold Islamic values while participating in the American legal system. For many, the biggest challenge is overcoming the stereotype that "lawyers are liars." This stigma not only creates doubt but also leads to hesitation about whether a career in law aligns with their religious and moral beliefs.

... For example, many believe it is haram ("prohibited") to work as a defense attorney for those accused of serious crimes, without understanding the ethical and constitutional role lawyers play. Defense attorneys, for example, are not there to condone crimes but to ensure that every person's rights are protected, and that justice is fairly administered...

... Personally, I experienced this struggle when I decided to pursue law. My family, like many in the Muslim community, was initially concerned about whether this path would compromise my principles. I spent a lot of time deepening my understanding of Islam while learning about the legal system to reconcile these concerns.

For instance, I discovered that the values of honesty, integrity, and justice—which are central to Islam—are also fundamental principles in law. It's not only possible but necessary for Muslims to bring these values into the legal profession, where they can act as a force for good...

Sampan: Do you have concerns that some people interested in law will not pursue the field because of the pervasive anti-Muslim bias in the U.S.? The recent story of Adeel Mangi and his failed bid for the U.S. Court of Appeals seems to just be the latest example, on top of many.

Aydah: Yes, anti-Muslim bias is a

significant concern and can deter many from pursuing a career in law. Stories like Adeel Mangi's failed judicial nomination are stark reminders of the challenges Muslims face in the legal profession, even when they are highly qualified and accomplished.

When I entered law school, I expected a non-diverse, potentially hostile environment. My personal experiences growing up in Palestine, where oppression was a daily reality, fueled my determination to use the law as a tool for justice. My mindset was to get through law school, earn my degree, and use it to make a difference.

I was fortunate to attend Western New England University, which was far more diverse and supportive than I anticipated. The faculty and student body were welcoming, and I was able to thrive in an environment that valued inclusivity. Unfortunately, I know this isn't the reality for many Muslim law students across the country.

Outside of academia, the legal profession still grapples with systemic bias. As an attorney recently admitted to the bar, I am beginning to witness the subtle and overt ways anti-Muslim sentiment can manifest in the workplace and the courtroom. Despite this, I believe the resilience and determination of the newer generations of Muslims will shine through.

Younger Muslims are increasingly breaking barriers, pursuing fields once considered inaccessible, and challenging stereotypes. They embody the values of their faith while striving to create positive change in their communities. The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) taught us, "The best of you are those who bring the greatest benefit to others." For Muslims, this teaching underscores the importance of contributing to society, even in the face of adversity....

Sampan: What are some ways people who do not practice Muslim faith or who are not of Arabic background, can help speak up against anti-Muslim and anti-Arabic biases?

Aydah: There are many ways non-Muslims can be allies and actively work to combat anti-Muslim and anti-Arab biases. It starts with education and a willingness to engage in meaningful dialogue. Stereotypes often arise from a lack of understanding, and even small steps toward learning can have a significant impact.

One key way to support, is to show up. Attend events, workshops, and panels where Muslims share their experiences, culture, and faith. Simply being present signals solidarity and a willingness to learn. Ask thoughtful questions, listen with an open mind, and challenge your own preconceptions.

Cultural competency is another critical area. Non-Muslims can educate

themselves about Islam and Arab culture, even at a basic level. For example, understanding that Muslims value honesty, justice, and compassion can go a long way in countering harmful stereotypes. When you encounter misinformation or derogatory comments, speak up. Being an ally means using your voice to challenge bias when you see it, even in spaces where Muslims aren't present to advocate for themselves.

I've personally seen how impactful open dialogue can be. During my undergraduate studies, I had a professor who openly expressed anti-Muslim and anti-Arab sentiments in class. He even listed books he'd written portraying Muslims as terrorists. When I submitted a paper that presented Islam in a positive light, he refused to grade it and demanded I write an entirely new essay. Instead of complying, I requested a phone call to discuss the situation. In that hour-long conversation, he admitted he hadn't read my paper and had only skimmed the opening paragraphs. As I explained Islamic principles, he seemed shocked, as though hearing these concepts for the first time. By the end of the call, he gave me a passing grade and expressed interest in learning more.

This experience reinforced the power of education and direct dialogue. While I declined further discussions with that professor, it was clear he had never truly engaged with a Muslim before. That one conversation shifted his perspective, even slightly....

Expert: Lead, Other Risks Lurking in Drinking Water

As concerning amounts of contaminants are found in drinking water systems – whether it be "forever chemicals" or lead from corroding pipes – the Environmental Protection Agency has imposed the first national, legally enforceable drinking water standard in the nation.

This would reduce levels of contaminants but come at a cost of replacing and upgrading pipes. PFAS - or polyfluoroalkyl forever chemicals are estimated to contaminate dozens of public drinking water systems in 86 Massachusetts communities since, posing risks of thyroid disease and kidney cancer, according to experts. Lead is another problem, especially in buildings and homes with lead pipes or plumbing that uses a type of solder containing the heavy metal, creating risks for young children and pregnant women and others. Lead is a dangerous neurotoxin and there is no safe level of exposure, according to the EPA; lead can impair mental and physical development, and cause irreversible damage to the brain, in kids, and it can cause high blood pressure, heart disease, decreased kidney function, and cancer in

To find out more about the risk in water systems, the Sampan spoke with Kiera Alventosa, an environmental health organizer for Clean Water Action, an environmental advocacy group. Clean Water Action is collaborating with Chinese Cultural Connection, a non-profit aimed at supporting the Asian community in Malden. The two hosted a bilingual information session earlier this month.

Sampan: Has this problem of lead in drinking water and elsewhere disproportionately affected communities of color? If so, why?

Kiera: Lead in drinking water is an environmental injustice that disproportionately impacts communities of color and low-income communities. This is, in part, due to the history of redlining, in which government-sponsored housing corporations racially discriminated against communities of color in distributing federally backed loans in certain neighborhoods. The history of redlining continues to be felt today in terms of housing quality, and results in an uneven burden of dealing with older homes and aging lead pipes.

The installation of new lead pipes was banned in 1986. Anyone who is living in a home older than 1986 should check their public water system's dashboard to see if they have a lead service line. A lead service line is a pipe that delivers water into the home from the water main under the street and is often the greatest contributor to lead in drinking water. As of October, every public water system is required to have a service line inventory posted.

Sampan: Are you satisfied with the measures the (recent) Biden/Harris administration took to regulate lead control? If not, why not?

Kiera: The Biden-Harris administration made unprecedented investments in addressing lead service lines including \$15 billion through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and an additional \$11.7 billion for

drinking water projects. These historic investments continue to make a real difference to communities on the ground through the financing of leadservice-line replacements. We also applaud the fact that the Biden-Harris administration demonstrated a clear priority of distributing resources to Environmental Justice communities, to help communities most impacted by pollution. These investments are just the start of the funding necessary to complete lead service line replacements across the country and ensure the right to safe clean drinking water, and we will continue to advocate for further action by the next administration.

Sampan: How do you feel about President-elected Trump's pick for EPA head, Lee Zeldin?

Kiera: As someone who grew up on Long Island, with Lee Zeldin as my Congressional Representative, I have concerns about many of his prior environmental stances and how this may impact his ability to protect our environment and public health on the national level. The prior Trump administration sought to remove safeguards to environmental health and worked on behalf of polluting industries to try to deregulate protections that should be rights.

Sampan: Are there adequate resources to inform non-English speaking residents about the dangers of lead in their water?

Kiera: There can always be more resources dedicated to language access equity, particularly for an important public health issue like lead in drinking water. The Clean Water Fund prioritizes information reaching non-English speaking residents and dedicates our resources to achieve this goal. This entails not only robust interpretation and translation for public engagement and educational events but also engaging with multilingual press and media sources. We partner with community groups from the outset who prioritize and celebrate the cultural specificity of each community. This allows multilingual information to reach families through the networks in which they are already connected and results in more effective engagement.

Sampan: On a state level, how does Massachusetts rank when it comes to public water safety? Do you have faith and confidence in Gov. Maura Healey and her administration's plans for Water safety? How would you like the state to spend its \$53.3 million awarded this past October?

Kiera: Massachusetts has some of the highest quality drinking water across the country and maintains stringent standards for water testing of public water systems. Lead enters drinking water from the wearing away of old pipes, not from the source water itself. Therefore, replacing lead service lines and plumbing is the best solution to eliminate lead from drinking water. Gov. Healy and her administration's plans inspire confidence for water safety through the prioritization of addressing PFAS and lead service line replacements. With increased funding, it is important to see a continued prioritization of Environmental Justice communities.

A Year in Film Review

Sampan's Arts Critic Harmony Witte Lists Top Picks of 2024

Looking back on 2024, Sampan's arts writer, Harmony Witte, compiled the following list of influential and important films of the year with connections to immigration in some way, or with foreign cast members. Some have immigration-focused stories, others have immigrant directors or actors or other cast members.

Witte's list includes hard-hitting documentaries, a martial arts adventure, both tense and funny crime stories, a surreal art romp and even a big-budget mystery thriller.

"This selection of films," writes Witte, "is of the ones that hung on in my mind long after viewing. Some of the films have already warranted a rewatch and some are so painful to see that scenes will be replayed mentally for years to come. In a year where so many of the films that made it into theater screenings were reboots, sequels, and prequels -- these were some of the unique takes that stuck out from the crowd."


Here are the Top 9 movies:

9: "Twilight of the Warriors: Walled In"

This is a martial arts film set in the walled-in city of Kowloon in the 1980s, when gangs ran the city. A refugee hides out in the city and finds his place in the community, but he has a secret that threatens to spark a gang war. This is an incredibly violent film with moments of real tenderness and humanity. It has some random CGI moments that may briefly pull viewers out of the created world, but those moments are few and far between. Directed by Soi Cheang, this film has one masterful fight sequence after another. Louis Koo shines as Cyclone, who tries to protect the inhabitants of the city.

8: "The Shallow Tale of a Writer Who Decided to Write About a Serial Killer"

This film tells the story of a writer in the midst of a divorce who befriends a serial killer who then pretends to be the



couple's marriage counselor. Directed by Tolga Karaçelik, from Istanbul, Turkey, this hilarious comedy drama features Steve Buscemi at the height of his comedic powers and wonderfully depicts the silent rage that can build between couples over time if smoldering issues are left unaddressed. The film is set in New York City and has a very casual approach to the cinematography that really works.

7: "The Trek: A Migrant Trail to America"

Here we have a CNN-produced documentary about people crossing the Darien Gap -- the only land route connecting South and Central America

which stretches between Colombia and Panama. The route is controlled by a drug cartel and people pay them to be able to pass through. Migrants make the hazardous journey coming from as far away as Haiti, Venezuela, Ecuador, China, and India, all with a dream of giving their family the best life possible There are no roads through the jungle, they climb mountains and wade through rivers and at times knee deep mud for 66 harrowing miles. This documentary features some graphic footage of people who did not survive the journey. It's a moving work that leaves the audience wondering about the fates of the people the crew encountered on the trail.

6: "Emilia Pérez (sp)"

Written and directed by Jacques Audiard, this is a Spanish-language musical crime comedy. The musical aspect was not advertised broadly, so some viewers may be surprised when the cast starts their heartfelt signing. It tells the story of four women in Mexico who are each pursuing their own chance at happiness. The film features a controversial storyline where a cartel leader wants gender affirming surgery and migrates to Switzerland to hide from authorities. The lead actresses in the film did a phenomenal job with this story including Zoe Saldaña, Karla Sofia Gascón, Selena Gomez, and Adriana Paz. While the singing was a little off putting at first, it became an amazing way to tell this fresh tale. There was one song with hundreds of faces of people highlighted across a black background in a Greek Chorus of sorts, all singing in unison about their missing loved ones which could make even the hardest of hearts emotional.

5: "No Other Land"

"No Other Land" is a documentary made by a four-person Palestinian-Israeli collective about a Palestinian hamlet called Masafer Yatta in the occupied West Bank. The film shows the expulsions of people from their homes and the systematic destruction of schools, homes, and even water wells on that land. It follows an activist named Basel Adra in his resistance to forced displacement by Israel's military and chronicles his friendship with Yuval Abraham, an Israeli journalist who attempts to help Basel in his struggle by bringing media attention to his plight. The bonds of friendship are tested because Yuval enjoys freedoms that Basel does not have such as the right to travel. This is a very moving documentary and features some very intense and shockingly violent scenes and scenes of Palestinian people's suffering under occupation and apartheid.

4: "Problemista"

Is a fantastic, surreal film directed by

former Saturday Night Live writer, Julio Torres, starring Torres as an aspiring toymaker from El Salvador who is trying to get a visa sponsored so he can continue living in the United States and reach his dreams. Alejandro tries gig jobs and eventually starts to work for an art world pariah in the hope that she will help him get his visa. Problemista also stars Tilda Swinton, RZA, and Isabella Rossellini. This film is delightfully surreal with wonderful special effects and manages to be incredibly endearing and heartfelt.

3: "Conclave"

In this mystery thriller the Pope has died, and the Cardinals must meet to select a new Pontiff -- only there are multiple scandals that erupt and threaten the very existence of the Catholic Church. "Conclave" has a twist ending that no one could see coming. It's beautifully shot with extraordinary acting, and the costumes, and sets are exquisite. The score by Volker Bertelmann is haunting and dramatic. Director Edward Berger, who was born in West Germany, displays his mastery at filmmaking with this visual feast.

2: "The Seed of the Sacred Fig"

A taut family drama directed by Mohammad Rasoulof, this is set against the backdrop of the real-life Iranian political protests in 2022, which were violently suppressed by Iranian authorities. When a Revolutionary Court judge's identity is publicly revealed, he and his wife and daughters must grapple with the destabilization of their family and society.

"The Seed of the Sacred Fig" weaves in graphic footage from the protests into this fictional story. The film was remarkably smuggled out of Iran after the director was sentenced to prison and fled the country. The acting by Soheila Golestani, Missagh Zareh, Satereh Maleki, and Mahsa Rostami in this film is superb.

1: "War Crimes in Gaza"

One of the most profoundly devastating pieces of documentary film ever released, "War Crimes in Gaza" is comprised of footage gathered from the social media accounts of Israeli forces and interviews with witnesses and experts which unflinchingly reports on the current grim situation in Palestine. This raw documentary is not for the faint of heart, with graphic, heart-wrenching scenarios and jarring interviews -- one after another. It's excruciating to watch and has lingered in my mind in the months since its release. Its message is to not turn away from the horrors that are being inflicted on the Palestinian people in what is being called the most-filmed genocide in history. Compiled and released by Al Jazeera Investigations, this documentary does not hold back. This film demands that the viewers watch and witness the war crimes and once seen. it cannot be denied that the audience is watching ethnic cleansing take place before their very eyes. This film didn't get a lot of attention in the United States when it was released, but as time passes it is sure to become very important documentation of what is taking place in Palestine.

State Doles Out Funds for Security Amid Hate Fears

A Chinese bible group, Boston-area Islamic society, Sikh group and several Jewish organizations were among the dozens of nonprofits given a total of \$5 million in funds earlier this month by the state to boost security amid increased fears of hate crimes.

The grants are supposed to support more than 100 nonprofit organizations identified as being "at high risk of hate crimes or terror attacks" so that they can enhance their security, according to a statement from the administration of Gov. Maura Healey. The administration says the funding is part of

larger investment in security improvements for nonprofits that totaled \$16.4 million in 2024.

Among those receiving the funds are the Chinese Bible Church of Greater Boston in Lexington that is getting nearly \$52,000; the Islamic Society of Boston and the Islamic Society of South Shore in Brockton, which are each getting \$75,000; the New England Hindu Temple in Ashland, which is getting nearly \$64,000; the Radha Krishna Mandir in Northborough, which is getting \$75,000; and the Sikh Sangat Society Boston, which is also getting \$75,000. Many other Jewish organizations and other groups are receiving funding as well.

These grants will help ensure the nonprofits can acquire needed resources to protect their organizations, according to Lt. Gov. Kim Driscoll.

The funds come from two state sources. The state Office of Grants and Research awarded more than \$4.4 million to 82 groups in the state for its fiscal 2025 Commonwealth Nonprofit Security Program. The other half million in funds was awarded to 20 nonprofits through the fiscal 2025

Commonwealth Nonprofit Security Personnel Grant Program. The latter program funds "high risk" organizations with the cost of contracted security personnel.

In addition, the groups will also get technical, grant management and reporting assistance from program coordinators assigned to Office of Grants and Research's Homeland Security Division.

The governor's office says the state saw 557 alleged hate crimes reported to police in 2023.
